However, last year put a halt to our monthly draws and the donations collected have been banked and are still there. I have kept note of those of you who paid last year and this will be carried on to this year. If you would like to take another number or if you would like to join please let me know and leave with Father Mario your £12 or cheque in an envelope with your name on it.

I will leave details of those of you who paid last year with your numbers. I also have three cheques that could not be cashed and I will return these to those concerned. I apologise for not returning them sooner but this has been due to shielding.

Father Mario will make the draw for April and May after the 9.15 Mass on the first Sunday in May [2nd May].

The 100+ club donations support charities in poorer parts of the world and is overseen by the Justice and Peace Committee. The charity chosen for the year or sometimes two years is generally a smaller charity with contacts with someone in the Parish. The committee welcomes any suggestions.

For £12 a year, you are given a number, which is entered into a monthly draw; the prizes are from £5, £10 and every three months £25. The more people who join the 100+ club, the larger the donation we are able to send to our charity.

I know that this past year has been challenging for everyone but if you are able to spare £12 for the year to join then in a small way we will be supporting those living without the benefits we have.
